Small way debate with for example neighbours when the are against refugees. Make contacts, show you're interested European level – show how different countries do this – what methods. Per refugee family – 2/3 native families that lead them the way Respect and expect the education of the refugees – they've to take the low way jobs – although they are high educated
<b>Messages to the Venhorst Declaration</b> Conclusion: On European level: we have to respect their education and don't put them automatically on low jobs. Also we have to share the methods of different countries according to accepting refugees in the society. In addition, small things do matter! Make contact, debate with your neighbour who's against refugees etc.
