Name of the workshop: Rural Pact – Village pact

Our responses to challenges:

To the biggest challenges of rural areas expressed by participants, we discuss the importance of active citizenship, empowering villagers and rural citizens. How to connect Europe with the grassroot level throw elevator organizations was our big response.

We focus on the importance of amplifying voices of rural areas, promoting mutual learning and encouraging and commitment. The lack of trust that rural citizens have shows us the necessary path of rebuilding community and to ensure that voices of local level are being heard.

Our three proposals for governments & EU

- 2. The Rural Pact should support mutual learning of local communities in cooperation with Elevator organizations like ERCA.
- 3. Further development of Village Pact community planning should be one of the new initiatives in the Rural Pact.
